- We offer 3 sizes of Mobile Farm – Small, Medium and Large.

- Eol - Expression of Interest Form – please complete the Eol form on page 11 and return to us.
- On receipt of your Eol form Katherine or Dan will contact you by telephone to chat through your booking, discuss a suitable programme and check access for our farm truck/trailer.
- We will then email you a programme for the visit and a quotation.
- Please confirm the booking by email.
- Please note – the maximum distance we can travel is 1 hour from the farm – any further is too stressful for our young animals
